



## **Greetings Southeast Texas Community Leader,**

The much-anticipated 4<sup>th</sup> Annual SETX Women in Industry Week will be held March 24 – 27, 2025. Female leaders from the Southeast Texas industrial community will unite with the goal of mentoring young ladies in schools across the region who have shown an interest in industry--related careers. There will be a variety of exciting events throughout the week that connect students with female executives in a broad range of careers and specialties.

The schedule of events includes:

- **Women in Industry Mixer at the *Art Museum of Southeast Texas*- March 24, 2025**

Women in industry from across the region are invited to this opening event. This is a social mixer meant to introduce subject matter experts, event hosts, and other attendees to one another.

- **Women in Industry Networking Luncheon at *Port Arthur Civic Center*- March 25, 2025**

More than 100+ (female) leaders in industry and 100+ students interested in following in their footsteps are invited to the luncheon. The luncheon, presented in a unique format, provides a platform for each leader to tell their story to their table, but also engage in meaningful conversation with student-attendees, to share their lessons learned and the path they took to get to where they are today.

- **Coffee Chats with college students across the region- March 26, 2025**

College students are invited to have one-on-one conversations with leaders in industry. A full Coffee Chat schedule will be available in early 2025.

- **Speed Mentoring at regional high schools- March 27, 2025**

Facilitated by the US Coast Guard, speed mentoring opportunities are offered to the area high schools, where industry professionals start the framework for mentor-mentee relationships with quick one-on-one mentoring sessions.

- **Student STEM Scholarship- Dates to be determined by individual schools**

Sponsors who have scholarship opportunities included in their 2024 sponsorship package are invited to present their associated scholarship to female students selected by Southeast Texas Women in Industry who are pursuing higher education tied to STEM careers. Scholarships can be presented at each school's respective end-of-year banquet. Companies are welcome to add scholarships if one does not exist with their chosen sponsorship.

SETX Women in Industry, a 501(c)3 organization, will coordinate the week-long initiative that includes 20+ events meant to inspire and encourage female students to pursue careers in industry. Proceeds will fund scholarships for female students going into the industrial workforce, with the sponsor playing a key role in the allocation of those funds.
